SELECTION CRITERIA:

1. Nominees will be considered without regard to race, religion, or background.
2. Nominees must be 18 years of age or older (as of 1/1/2010).
3. Nominees must be a resident of southern Illinois for a minimum of five (5) years.
4. Steering Committee members of the Southern Illinois Women's Health Conference and the Southern Illinois Women's Teen Conference may be nominees.
5. Members of the Board of Directors of Women for Health and Wellness, Inc. and the Rosemary Berkel Crisp Award Selection Committee may not be nominees.
6. One letter of nomination is required. At least two additional letters from individuals are required. The letters should cite examples of how the nominee has contributed to the betterment of southern Illinois residents.
7. Additional supporting evidence, including testimonials or additional documentation, is strongly encouraged. Curriculum Vitas should not be sent. Please limit resumes to two (2) pages.
8. Nominees will be considered based on their volunteer efforts or personal contributions to the advancement or support of others or their community. These should not be part of the nominee's job duties.

The winner will receive a \$350 honorarium and a Swarovski crystal heart. A \$350 contribution will be made in honor of the winner to a 501(c)3 charity, selected by the winner.
